Naval Station (NS), Great Lakes, trains and prepares thousands of sailors in various occupations. Since the Navy recognizes that leisure activities are an essential element in the retention and physical and mental well being of Navy personnel, the **Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Department has a very vital and important role to play in the lives of military personnel.**



The overall mission of the MWR Department is to provide Navy personnel and their dependents with varied programs of wholesome and constructive off-duty leisure activities. Included in this mission is the orientation and instruction of all eligible users as to what recreation is, what is available and how to become a part of it through participation. Alternatives to substance abuse and boredom, physical readiness, family happiness and customer satisfaction are integral parts of the total MWR mission.

MWR at Great Lakes **provides a variety of leisure activities to a very diverse population**, serving a population of approximately 25,000 active duty military, their dependents, drilling reservists, retired military and Department of Defense (DoD) civilians. The MWR Department employs over 300 employees and is considered one of the largest MWR Departments in the Navy. The annual operating

budget is over 17 million dollars. MWR's many branches and facilities provide a wide variety of leisure activities, which include a bowling center, marina, golf course, library, tickets and travel office, gymnasiums, indoor pools, beach, fitness centers, outdoor recreation, climbing wall, enlisted recreation center, movie theater, softball fields, banquet/conference center, enlisted entertainment center/night club along with numerous special events. In addition, a personnel, accounting and a marketing branch provide support services.
